

Consultants from the INTOSAI Development Initiative (IDI) pay a courtesy visit to the AG's office

Two consultants from the SAI of Norway, Mr. Haldal Ingvald and Ms. Lise Magrethe Hansen, made a courtesy visit to the SAI's Head, Mr. Junias Etuna Kandjeke, and his Deputy, Mr Goms Menettè, to briefly discuss the SAI PMF process. The SAI Performance Measurement Framework (SAI PMF) was created to help SAIs measure their performance, identify their primary strengths and weaknesses. Under the supervision and strategic guidance of the INTOSAI Development Initiative (IDI), the two consultants visited the Auditor-General's Office.
