The workshop aimed at assisting the OAG to perform a holistic, evidence-based assessment of its current strengths and weaknesses at institutional, organizational, and professional levels. Two IDI consultants, Mr. Heldal Ingvald and Ms. Lise Norway, assisted the team in starting the SAI PMF process. The SAI PMF offers Supreme Audit Institutions (SAIs) a framework for evaluating SAI performance in a holistic and evidence-based manner. This gives SAIs a solid foundation on which to demonstrate their continued relevance to residents and other stakeholders. During this workshop, the team completed the Terms of Reference for the proposed visit of the consultants during the week of 18-22 October 2021.

The participating teams primarily focused on Independence and Legal Framework, Internal Governance and Ethics; and Performance Audits within the OAG. The assessment's findings will be utilized to serve as a strong baseline for planning, performance management, monitoring, evaluation and reporting and developing a needs-based, prioritized strategic plan for the period 2022-2027 and annual operational plans linked to the strategic plan.
