

OAG Frontline Workers Receive Training on COVID-19 Disinfection

The OAG, through its Human Resource Training Division and annual training plan, trained its frontline workers on COVID-19 office disinfection and protocols.

In order to comply with the Office strategic objective of enhancing the utilization of SAI's resources in terms of efficiency, effectiveness and economy, the front line workers received training on Covid-19 disinfection which is carried out when there are confirmed or suspected cases of COVID-19 on-site.

Cleaning and disinfection of common touchpoints such as handrails and door handles, to minimize the risk for microbial transfer formed part of this training to ensure that the OAG premises are disinfected in a safe, thorough, legally compliant manner.

Through this training, the OAG front-line workers were equipped not only with hands-on skills but also with the necessary personal protective equipment, respiratory protective equipment and specialist disinfection equipment to work safely and effectively. OAG frontline workers are now fully trained on how to disinfect it's headquarter in the event that the Office confirms future Covid-19 positive cases amongst its staff. This will ensure the OAG to save public money on recruiting private companies for disinfection.
