

SAI Namibia and AFROSAI-E Secretariat Meet to Assess the Key Components of the Financial Audit Manual

Supreme Audit Institution (SAI) of Namibia partnered with AFROSAI-E Secretariat to capacitate the SAI's auditors on key components of the Financial Audit Manual, covering mainly Risk Assessment and refreshers on materiality and sampling.

As part of its public interest mandate, OAG contributes to the development, adoption and implementation of high-quality auditing and assurance standards, primarily over its support of the International Auditing standards through workshops such as this.

The training which was specifically envisioned for Financial Auditors from the Cash and Accrual Based Audit Directorates of the OAG, aimed at facilitating the professional exchange between SAI's auditors to guarantee comparable and high quality standards for controls. Auditors need continuous updates in order to ensure that standards and methodology are correctly applied as adopted. The workshop focused on processes and output factors that contribute to audit quality at the engagement and national levels for auditors of OAG. During this informative training, Resource Persons from SAI's Kenya, Zimbabwe and Uganda were invited to share experiences and best practices in order to close the identified gaps.

This training supported auditors to keep abreast with the amendments in the international audit standards and allow them to close the identified gaps as identified in the peer reviews.
